MAPS GENERAL CIRCULAR NO.1/2020

Interim Accreditation – Architecture Programme

OBJECTIVE

1. This Circular explains the process of application for **Programme Approval** until the Architectural Education Provider (AEP) is ready to apply for an **Accreditation Visit**.

GENERAL REQUIREMENT

- 2. Subsection 2.3.1 of The Manual of Accreditation for Architecture Programme (2013) or 'MAAP' describes the process of application for **Programme Approval**.
- 3. Upon receipt of consent for **Programme Approval** from the Board, thereafter AEP is placed under **candidature status** with a validity period of two-years (refer subsection 5.2.1). Thus, the AEP is expected to implement the approved programme at the earliest possible time (refer subsection 2.3.2) but shall not exceed the said validity period.
- 4. In addition to the above, the moment the AEP implements the approved programme its candidature status will be automatically concluded and will be replaced with a new status called **Interim Accreditation**. Such AEP is required to inform the Council one (1) month before the approved programme is being implemented.
- 5. An **Interim Accreditation** certificate in both hardcopy and softcopy will be issued by the LAM and shall be displayed at the front office of the Faculty where the AEP official premise is located.
- 6. The **Interim Accreditation** will be granted for a period of five (5) years for LAM Part I and four (4) years for LAM Part II starting from the date of programme implementation.

- 7. Subsequently, application for both LAM Part I and LAM Part II programmes will be given a maximum of three (3) attempts to apply for the first **Accreditation Visit** (for further details refer subsection 2.4.2 and MAPS Circular No. 1/2018).
- 8. Failure to secure an Accreditation or at least Conditional Accreditation within the period or attempts mentioned in items 6 and 7 above shall lead to the programme accreditation being withdrawn by the Board.
